Taking development to rural areas

The Senator Uba Sani-led Administration has taken a bold step by performing the ground breaking for the construction of approximately 50 roads, totalling 639.5km across the three senatorial districts, in order to enhance connectivity and accessibility for residents, farmers, business owners, and other road users in the last one year.

hen he was campaigning for the Governorship, Senator Uba Sani promised to open up the hinterland for development because the Urban Renewal Programme had substantially upgraded the five city-based Local Governments of Kaduna North, Kaduna South, Zaria, Igabi and Chikun. In the last one year, Governor Uba Sani has unveiled a Rural Transformation Programme which has witnessed the ground breaking for

the construction of about 50 rural roads, covering about 639.5 km across the 23 Local Government Areas in the State. The Senator Uba Sani-led APC Government has also initiated the construction of three vocational and skills acquisition centres in Soba, Rigachikun and Zangon Kataf, representing Zones 1, 2 and 3, respectively. In addition, the repairs of vandalised electrification facilities and supply of transformers in rural areas across the state have almost been completed.

The rural transformation programme started with the

flag-off of the 21.7-kilometer road, linking Anchau, and Gadas-Palla road in Kubau and Ikara local governments When September. completed, the road will address the transportation challenges of 32 communities. In November, the Governor performed a more colourful, elaborate and expanded groundbreaking event Kudan local government, with the flag-off of the construction of a 10.2-kilometre feeder road, stretching from Dan Makwarwa to Hunkuyi.

On December 23, Governor Uba Sani flagged off roads, drainages and culvert construction across the eight Local Governments in

Southern Kaduna. The projects are spread across Jaba, Zangon Kataf, Kagarko, Sanga, Kaura, Kauru, Kachia and Jema'a Local Governments. Eight days later, he performed another groundbreaking event for an 18-kilometre road construction, linking Sanga Local Government to Jema'a Area Council. The road which started from Gwantu, through Kiban, will provide forward and backward linkages to farmers and markets, and reduce post-harvest losses, cost of transportation and travel time. Besides, it will employ skilled, semi-skilled and unskilled labour during the construction period.

In addition, Zone 2 witnessed its share of flagging off of road projects and the 35-kilometre road from Gadan Gayan, through Gwaraji to Kujama Junction, linking Igabi and Chikun Local Governments, in Kaduna Central Senatorial district has commenced in earnest. Also, contractors have mobilized to site to construct the 6-kilometre College Road in Sabon Tasha, from Signboard through Juji, connecting the Eastern Bypass. The road will cut across Igabi, Kaduna

North and Chikun Local Governments. The project includes the main road linking College Road to Millennium City and other feeder roads within the various districts. Besides, Governor Uba Sani also performed the ground-breaking ceremony of Nurus Siraj Unguwar Dosa New Extension Layout. In addition, a 15-span dual carriage bridge linking College Road to Mashigi is under construction.

On May 13th, Senator Uba Sani performed the groundbreaking for the reconstruction of the 1.4km Water Intake Road from Patrick Yakowa Way to Maigero Junction, and the upgrading and maintenance of the 3.15km Maigero - Narayi Junction Way, totalling 4.55km. Indeed, the completion of these two vital roads in Chikun Local Government, according to him, "will not only stimulate commercial activities within the areas but also significantly reduce travel time for residents. Furthermore, the construction of these roads will pave the way for a multitude of job opportunities, both directly and indirectly, thereby fostering a sense of hope and optimism for a brighter future among the communities."

Opening up Kaduna State for investments

fter assuming office, Senator Uba Sani went about marketing Kaduna State to foreign investors across the world. In no time, the efforts have started bearing fruits. Over a fortnight ago, the Governor's sustained efforts towards attracting investments in the mining sector manifested. Right now, arrangements are in top gear for the commissioning of the gigantic new

Lithium Processing Plant in Kaduna, a partnership between the Kaduna State Government and Ming Xin Mineral Separation Nigeria Ltd. On May 12, 2024, the Management of the Chinese mining firm, Ming Xin Mineral Separation Nigeria Ltd, led by its Executive Director, Business Development, Ms Leana Lee, briefed Senator Uba Sani on preparations for the commissioning. The facility has initial capacity of 1500 metric tonnes per day.

At the briefing which took place at Sir Kashim Ibrahim House, the Governor urged the Chinese firm to prioritize environmental protection to ensure safety of the host community. addition, he highlighted importance of community engagement, local content, Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) programs in their operations. "We shall continue to promote investmentfriendly policies to boost investors' confidence, provide employment opportunities for our citizens and boost our internally generated revenue (IGR)," he promised.

In fact, the search for investors has gone beyond promises. On May 13, 2024, Governor Uba Sani performed the ground breaking for the construction of the \$50 Million Soya Bean Oil Refining Plant by Sunagrow International Oil Ltd at Kutungare, a village in Igabi Local Government.

When completed, the Plant will have a production capacity of 500,000 litres per day, thereby contributing to the economic development of Kaduna and Nigeria. Thousands of direct and indirect jobs at various skill levels, from agricultural laborers to skilled technicians and engineers for the refinery operations, will be created. The project will enable the addition

of value to agricultural products by processing them into higher-value products such as soya oil and meal, increase the income potential of farmers and create opportunities for local businesses to supply raw materials to the company. In addition, there will be transfer of technology and technical know-how to technicians and artisans.

On August 15, Governor Uba Sani performed the ground breaking of the Sanabil Project, initiated by the Qatar Charity, for the construction of the Kaduna Economic City and the provision of Mass Housing on August 15. The Economic City will provide world class infrastructure, adequate security and conducive atmosphere for business activities. There will also be clinics, shops and poultry farms, including farmlands for all year agriculture. The city will facilitate international trade, by providing a platform that "will help harness product value chain opportunities and improve economic growth," the Governor had promised.

The Qatar Charity will also provide scholarship and other empowerment programmes for the poor, underserved and vulnerable children across the 23 local governments. In fact, it will distribute sewing machines, welding machines and irrigation pumping machines, as well as salon kits to eligible beneficiaries. In addition, boreholes will be drilled for deserving communities by the Qatar Charity.

On October 23, 2023, the Governor recorded a major feat in the aviation sector, when Air Peace commenced flight to Kaduna. Earlier, Senator Uba Sani had met with aviation stakeholders, including the Minister of Aviation and Aerospace Development, Mr Festus Keyamo, in his efforts to revive the Kaduna International Airport. Thereafter, he engaged with Barrister Allen Onyeama, Chairman of Air Peace, on October 15 in Abuja. Eight days later, the first flight touched down at the airport, after a 19-month absence. On March 26, 2022, bandits had attacked the airport and Azman had suspended its services and left Kaduna. Largely, the airport had been dormant since then, until Senator Uba Sani's intervention.

Likewise, a Liquefied Natural Gas production and distribution company, the Greenville LNG, has sited a 24,000 tonnes capacity facility at Kakau, a village in Chikun local government of Kaduna State. According to the Chairman, Mr Eddy Van Den Broeke, the Compressed Natural Gas will reduce petroleum and diesel

consumption across the country, provide an economical and ecofriendly fuel alternative. In addition, it will revive industries, boost micro, small and medium scale business. The company will also engender economic growth and create jobs, as well as address the state's needed energy security. The facility was the first of its kind in Nigeria and Kaduna State will benefit from the multi-billion dollar investment.

Senator Uba Sani had also met with the Ambassador of the United Arab Emirates (UAE), Salem Saeed Alshamsi and His Excellency made some commitments. Al Shamsi promised that UAE will facilitate multimillion dollar private investments to Kaduna State in the Agriculture, Infrastructure, Transportation and Clean Energy sectors. Additionally, the Emirati Government will support Kaduna State Government to address its developmental challenges.

All these investments and commitments which have been secured within one year in omce, are the result of Governor Uba Sani's drive and commitment to attract investments to Kaduna State, in order to provide jobs, boost Internally Generated Revenue and make the State an investment hub.



School fees of Kaduna State owned tertiary institutions have been reviewed

Reinforcing Kaduna as centre of learning

In the last one year, Kaduna State Government has reduced school fees in its tertiary schools, upgraded infrastructure and provided facilities in schools, built new blocks of classrooms and trained teachers in its efforts to invest in Human Capital, one of the goals of the Senator Uba Sani administration, as captured in his SUSTAIN Manifesto.

Lowerist ducation is one of the key components of Human Capital which is an important pivot of the SUSTAIN Manifesto of the Senator Uba Sani administration. Not surprising, one of the first popular decisions that the Governor took upon assuming office was slashing the school fees of Kaduna State-owned tertiary institutions on August 21. In the downward review, Kaduna State University's (KASU's) school fees was reduced from N150,000 to N105,000 per semester. Similarly, the fees of Nuhu Bamalli Polytechnic, a Zaria

based institution, has been reduced from N100,000 to N50,000. In addition, College of Education, Gidan Waya, now charges N37,500 instead of N75,000 per semester. Likewise, students of Shehu Idris College of Health Sciences, across all courses, will enjoy new fees regime. Indeed, charges for Higher National Diploma courses have also been reduced from N100,000 to N70,000, while National Diploma students will now pay N52, 000 instead of N75,000. About six months earlier, students, parents and focal groups, had complained of exorbitant school fees during the last gubernatorial campaign. Senator Uba

Sani, the then APC candidate, had promised a downward review.

Besides, Kaduna State Government has approved the establishment of a new campus of Kaduna State College of Education, Gidan Waya at Hunkuyi in Kudan Local Government Area, in an effort to increase access to higher education. In the same vein, the Kaduna State Scholarship and Loans Board released N205 million, on August 25, to various tertiary institutions across the country. The release was the payment of tuition fees of students on scholarship. Bayero University Kano received N25 million, in fulfilment of an MoU, for the students' tuition fees till their graduation. Ahmadu Bello University, Zaria, got N27 million while KASU received N88.63 million. In addition, the scholarship board will enter similar agreements with Kaduna Polytechnic, University of Jos, ATBU Bauchi, Kaduna State College of Nursing amongst others.

Apart from tertiary institutions, the Senator Uba Sani administration has embarked on a massive infrastructural revitalization of primary and secondary schools across Kaduna State, including

construction of classrooms, the laboratories, administrative blocks, and multi-purpose halls. Two weeks ago, the Deputy Governor, Dr. Hadiza S Balarabe inaugurated the new Girls Science Secondary School in Pambeguwa, Kubau Local Government Area, one of the six new science schools constructed across the state. Equipped with state-ofthe-art facilities aimed at advancing science education, the construction costs N6,834,564,828.52, equipment worth N2,536,598,623.89. Additionally, the Deputy Governor inspected the newly constructed classrooms facilities and Government Secondary School Kamfanin Maude, is one of 62 new secondary schools built by the Senator Uba Sani administration.

In the last one year, Governor Uba Sani has constructed 2,326 new classrooms, providing space for 93,040 pupils. In addition, his Government has provided 30,742 two-seater desks, accommodating 61,484 pupils, to promote learning in a comfortable and respectful environment. Also, the Administration has installed hygienic toilets and hand pumps for clean drinking water in schools. Similarly, the Kaduna State Government has renovated 707 classrooms, distributed over 34,000 pieces of furniture for both pupils and teachers. Apart from renovation and upgrade, the Government has established and improved the following schools, Sani

Adamu Primary School in Tuchan Jukan, and Basic Education School in Kagadanma. Others are Shehu Idris Basic Education School in Babban Dodo, Ambassador Lawal Sambo Kodar Kona in Zaria and Government Girls Secondary School in Fada, Zarla. The rest are LGEA Primary School on Lokoja Road, Rigasa, Basic Education School in Malali and Nomadic Nursery and Primary School in Rafin Guza. Within one year, the Uba Sani Administration has also improved Basic Education School in Bagado, Chikun, Ja'afaru Model Primary School in Sabon Gari, Zaria, and LGEA Primary School in Ungwan Mua'azu. In addition, the Governor has improved Basic Education School in Baddiko, LGEA Primary School in Maraban Jos and Basic as well as Education School in Danbushiya, including Government Junior Secondary School in Jere.

In addition, Kaduna State Universal Basic Education(SUBEB) has been training teachers to upscale their knowledge of Reading and Numeracy

Activities(RANA), three-year project funded by DFID through UNICEF as part of the Girls Education Programme Phase 3. The programme is aimed at improving literacy and numeracy instruction in grades one to three in both public schools and integrated Quranic schools, with the ultimate goal of increasing literacy outcomes for learners, especially girls. To achieve these goals, RANA has developed Hausa-language teaching and learning materials, built teacher capacity, mobilised communities, and engaged Local Governments to improve early grade reading policies.

The trenches to fight for the restoration of democracy and agitate for human rights, Governor Uba Sani's pro-poor policies in Kaduna State are in line with his antecedents, whether as an activist or a Senator of the Federal Republic of Nigeria. Barely two months in office, he signed the First Executive Order on Financial Inclusion in Kaduna

State and constituted a committee on Financial Inclusion and Literacy on July 25. According to him, the Order aims to address the financial exclusion of about 2.1 million poor people in the State, including vulnerable indigent citizens in rural areas. More so, the order seeks to ensure that they benefit from the social interventions of both State and Federal Governments.

To achieve the desired objective, the Governor set up a Financial Inclusion and Literacy Committee to fashion out strategies and modalities to onboard them to financial services. The committee which included Government officials, members of the Civil Society and Financial Technology Companies (FINTECHS), was also charged with the responsibility of 'developing state register of the poor, under-served, and vulnerable," the Governor said. He further promised that 'the register will be subjected to various stages of integrity tests, while the state government will work with

banks and other financial service providers to open bank accounts for un-banked citizens." He promised that Kaduna State Government will collaborate with regulatory agencies in the financial sector to organise financial literacy workshops for them.

In the last one year, Senator Uba Sani's poverty alleviation and pro-poor policies have been well planned and coordinated, involving stakeholder engagements. For example, when the Federal Government doled out N2 billion to the States to cushion the effects of the removal of petroleum subsidy, he convened a meeting, comprising government officials, representatives of trade unions, representatives of faith-based organizations, persons with disabilities, market and transport unions, and the private sector. The meeting fashioned out a three-stage plan to soften the impact of fuel subsidy removal on the residents of Kaduna State. According to the Governor, the meeting listed out short, medium and long-term plans to cushion the effects of the Federal Government policy. The first priority, which was the shortterm plan, was the distribution of food items to one million and fifty thousand people, drawn from two hundred and ten thousand households. This phase has since been implemented and

the families headed by people with disabilities, widows and the elderly were considered first. Other vulnerable households, orphanages and Internally Displaced Persons camps were also given special attention.

Last March, Governor Uba Sani flagged-off the second phase of the distribution of food items to vulnerable residents during which N3.4 billion worth of rice and maize were given out. Approximately, 200,000 households and 1,000,000 persons benefitted. In addition, grants have been released to 7,500 Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises

(MSMEs), ranging between N100,000 and N1 million, depending on the size of the enterprise. Also, N4.2 billion have been distributed as cash grants, bags of fertilizer, and farm inputs to smallholder farmers. Also, MSMESs, persons with disabilities, Internally Displaced Persons (IDPs), orphans, market women, and youths benefited. In the same vein, N3.3 billion has been released for the payment of pensions and gratuities, as well as death benefits to families of deceased civil servants. This is just as a N500 million revolving loan scheme has been instituted for civil servants.

In fact, it will distribute sewing machines, welding machines and irrigation pumping machines, as well as salon kits to eligible beneficiaries. It did that by procuring 12,800 units of three different agrochemicals which were distributed to 3,294 small holder farmers across the 7 Ginger producing local government areas. As part of the implemention of the Agricultural Transformation Plan in the SUSTAIN Agenda of His Excellency, the Ministry of Agriculture will have access to #2 Billion for the subsidy of fertilizer for 2024 farming season. Thus, increase in the yield of the 57,000 potential beneficiaries and improve their income. The Ministry has also executed an exhaustive campaign against the threat of rabies in and around the state as 2,000 Dogs were vaccinated across the state, Preexposure Anti-Rabbies vaccination was administered to 62 state Veterinary Doctors, 4 NDA Veterinary Staff, 24 Livestock Officers, 5 Dog breeders, 2 Local government area officers, 4 Community animal health care workers and 23 Diseas Surveillance Officers.

Avian Influenza (Bird flu) Mitigation is a nother area where the administration has recorded success as the Ministry of Agriculture has collaborated with Olam Agric to carry out awareness sensitization and decontamination of live bird markets in Kaduna and Zaria zone; about 1,000 copies of advisory literature on Avian Influenza were distributed, 3 Poultry farms were decontaminated, 7 major live bird Markets in the state were also decontaminated.

The administration of Malam Uba Sani has maintained the Agric Policy of the state by scaling up the agricultural sector in order to meet up with the global challenges in the agri-food and value chain systems by moving the state to the most outstanding position in agricultural productivity and is collaborating with the International Development Association and other related agencies for the development of the sector.

It is on this note that the effort of Kaduna State government in collaboration with the donor agencies provided various projects thus serving various purposes with the sole aim of agricultural development in the state. Projects like the APPEALS, RAAMP, L-PRESS, SAPZ, KADA are all out to lift farming and of course farmers in Kaduna State.

In the realm of leadership, Robin S. Sharma once aptly remarked, "Leadership is not about a title or designation. It's about impact, influence, and inspiration." This sentiment resonates profoundly in the transformative leadership of Sule Shu'aibu SAN, the Kaduna State Attorney General and Commissioner for Justice.

Beyond the Executive role bestowed on him, Sule Shu'aibu exudes a passion for success and a commitment to impactful leadership. He opens his doors wide, eager to listen, firmly believing that when staff are provided with their essentials, productivity is boosted. His mantra encapsulates this dedication, stating, "My primary focus at the Ministry is the welfare of our staff and counsel."

Upon assuming the mantle of Commissioner for Justice, he engaged with Department heads and members, probing into their concerns, which led to the recognition of considerable discontent due to inadequate welfare measures and budget constraints. He promptly addressed issues such as timely salary payments and allowances, particularly for casual staff. Staff affirmed that this people-centered approach was both surprising and invigorating, instilling a renewed desire to serve with satisfaction.

The Ministry has successfully implemented a functional Case Management System, an advanced automated database designed for recording, storing, and retrieving case files. This innovative system has transformed workflow, allowing efficiency in uploads and management of case files. Lawyers are now utilizing this technology to streamline their tasks, significantly enhancing the efficiency and accuracy of their work.

In addition, the Ministry is actively addressing concerns related to witness funds, which were seldom approved, causing hindrances to the legal process and causing frustration among lawyers. Moreover, the Ministry has undertaken the payment of practicing fees for lawyers, marking an unprecedented move after several years of nonpayment. A considerable number of lawyers, relying solely on their legal practice for income, are grappling with the harsh realities of economic challenges. Over time, this struggle has taken a toll on their productivity and commitment. However, the proactive efforts of the Attorney General in addressing the needs of lawyers serve as a catalyst, boosting performance and instilling hope and trust in the legal system. This has created an atmosphere of gratitude at the Ministry of Justice, with a visible willingness among the legal practitioners to exert the necessary efforts. The prevailing sentiment among lawyers is encapsulated in the phrase, "to whom much is given, much is expected," underscoring their commitment to performing their duties to the best of their ability.

Understanding the pivotal role of the work environment, the Commissioner is overseeing renovations of Ministry offices. Dilapidated spaces are receiving a facelift, ensuring functional doors and basic facilities, creating an environment conducive to optimal performance.

Extending his conscientious leadership to branch offices in Saminaka, Zaria, and Kafanchan, Sule Shu'aibu recently toured these locations. Assessing conditions and hearing directly from staff about challenges affecting service delivery, he evaluated aspects such as water supply, security, and sanitation. The Commissioner emphasized swift resolution of raised issues, demonstrating his commitment to inclusive leadership.

To tackle the backlog of cases against the

government, the Commissioner submitted a proposal to Senator Uba Sani, the Executive Governor, urging the creation of a dedicated committee. Senator Uba Sani endorsed the proposal, resulting in the establishment of the committee which is currently developing strategies to engage litigants and formulate effective solutions for the amicable resolution of pending issues. The primary objective is to substantially reduce the overwhelming number of cases to a more manageable level. The committee's members include, the Solicitor General, the heads of KASUPDA, KADIPA, KADGIS, Ministry of Finance, and Ministry of Budget and Planning.

According to the 2023 Justice Needs Satisfaction survey by The Hague Institute for Innovation of Law, 81% of Nigerians encountered at least one legal issue in the preceding year. Common problems included disputes with neighbours, domestic violence, and land disputes. The report reveals that while nearly 9 in 10 Nigerians take action to address their legal concerns, a significant majority of these issues never progress to the formal justice system, likely due to the challenges associated with court proceedings.

In response to these findings, the report advocates for targeted improvements in various facets of the justice system, including administrative processes, work environments, staffing, and alternative dispute resolution mechanisms. By prioritizing these areas, a more efficient and accessible legal framework that better serves the needs of the Nigerian populace van be achieved.

Recognizing the importance of collaboration and collective action in tackling the myriad legal issues confronting Kaduna State, the Attorney General and key management staff have embarked on a series of strategic

KDSG meets RAAMP requirements, set to enhance rural access to agric marketing

he Rural Access and Agricultural Marketing Project (RAAMP) is a third-generation rural access project supported by the International Development Association (IDA), a subsidiary of the World Bank and the French Development Agency.

Kaduna State was selected in June 2022 by the Federal Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development to participate in the RAAMP with components to include; A: Improvement of Rural Access and Trading Infrastructure

B: Asset Management, Agro-logistics Performance Enhancement and Sector Reform

C: Institutional Development, Project Management and Risk Mitigation and D: Contingent Emergency Response. The RAAMP in Kaduna State became effective on the 31st August,2022 alongside 18 States making it a 19 states affair in Nigeria. RARA and SRF simply mean Rural Access Road Authority and State Roads Fund respectively. These two are going hand in hand as they are legal covenants that must be established "no later than 18months after the date of the subsidiary agreement between the RAAMP and the participating state". By implication, the RARA and SRF ought to have been in the State House of Assembly by March 2024. Thanks to Sen. UBA SANI the administration which has deliberated upon the Bills and forwarded to the State House of Assembly for legislation.

Earlier on the 15th June, 2023 the Kaduna RAAMP had a sensitisation

meeting at Planning and Budget Commission's Conference Hall which is one of the criteria for establishing the bill for the State Executive to deliberate upon. The meeting had in attendance stakeholders from various MDAs, Organizations from within and outside the state. It also included Professional and Civil Society Organizations for their input.

It was followed by stakeholders workshop on the 17th July, 2023 at the same venue of Budget and Planning Commission where it hosted the Chief of Staff to the Governor of Kaduna State, Mal. Sani Kila, the then Algon Chairman Mal. Abubakar Buba, 4 Assembly Members from Birnin Gwari, Giwa, Kubau and Kajuru, National Coordinator, RAAMP Mal. Aminu Bodinga and his team and many senior civil servants from various MDAs. The workshop signified the level of commitment of Kaduna RAAMP to the Bills. The Bill was prepared based on the input of various stakeholders by the State Ministry of Justice and then put forward to the State Council for deliberations.

On the 20th March, 2024, Hon. Mohammed Al Hassan, Chairman House Committee on Roads Agency (KADRA) and Judiciary presented a report on a Bill to establish the Kaduna Rural Access Roads Authority (KADRARA) for the purpose of designing, developing, managing, rehabilitating, reconstructing and maintaining class C and D roads in Kaduna State, as well as for other matters connected herewith 2024. The report presented was adopted by the Honourable House and subsequently

passed into law.

On the 2nd April, 2024, Governor Uba Sani assented to the Bills from the Kaduna State House of Assembly. The bills were presented to the Governor by the Majority Leader of the House, Hon. Munira Suleiman Tanimu.

According to the Majority Leader, "The Kaduna State House of Assembly remains committed to working closely with the Executive Arm towards ensuring the delivery of the dividends of democracy to the good people of Kaduna State".

On the whole of the 19 States of Nigeria participating in RAAMP,

Kaduna state would be among the few states that have attained the requirement expected by RAAMP. This will go a long way in achieving implementation of sector reform and thus achieving sustainability of Rural Access and Agricultural marketing project whose main objective is to improve rural access and agricultural marketing in participating states while strengthening the financing and institutional base for effective development, maintenance and management of the rural road network. It is on record that Kaduna state has performed very well in RAMP1, therefore, the assent of these Bills into law by His Excellency Sen. Uba Sani is a clear indication that Kaduna state is ever ready to maintain its status.

Kaduna RAAMP under leadership of the state Coordinator, Engr. Zubairu Abubakar FNSE, is to say the least, a team of positive full of energy minds set towards achieving project development objectives.

Gov Sani Unveils \$20 Million Lithium Processing Plant

n a significant move to boost investmentin the mining sector, Kaduna State Governor, Senator Uba Sani, has commissioned a state-of-the-art Lithium Processing Plant in Kangimi, Igabi Local Government Area, which is a joint venture between the Kaduna State Government and Ming Xin Mineral Separation Nigeria Ltd, boasts an impressive initial capacity of 1,500 metric tonnes per day.

The main details of the project include: 1. Job Creation: The project is expected to create over three thousand job opportunities, benefiting both the Kuriga mining site and the Kangimi processing plant.

2. Investment: The current investment stands at \$20 million, with plans to increase it to \$25 million within the next two years.

Open Government Partnership: Kaduna leads in youth participation

aduna State has a very youthful population, 81% are said to be below 35 years, with a huge potential for demographic dividends if meaningfully harnessed. Democracy is about the majority having their way, so public policies, plans, budgets, service delivery and reforms should reflect the needs and aspirations of the youths. This fact is buttressed by the Demographic Dividends Report for Kaduna State, 2019, where it stated, "Kaduna State has one of the largest proportion and numbers of youths in Nigeria, it is important to plan for how they can be part of, and contribute to the social and economic development of the State."

It is not news that Kaduna State is the first subnational in Nigeria to sign onto the Open Government Partnership (OGP) global/local community; and is currently implementing its third action plan. However, what is missing in the headlines is that three youths, including a female, below 29 years of age, are members of the OGP State Steering Committee. One of them is currently serving as the Committee's Civil Society Co-chair and the remaining two are leading Technical Working Groups (TWGs). This is a novel achievement at least at the subnational level in Nigeria, if not in Africa.

Notably, it is confidence boosting for the youths, as one of them is now sitting on the OGP table as a Co-chair with the Honorable Commissioner, Kaduna State Planning & Budget Commission, co-creating high-level reform decisions. More so, platforms such as the OpenGov Youth Innovation Hub have enabled youths (between the age grade of 18-29 years) to actively participate and inform the development of the third State Action Plan (SAP, 2024-2025) of the OGP. The Hub had proposed and submitted nine milestones that were captured, four of which are climate-change related, across the five OGP commitment areas.

In addition, the Hub analyzed the 2024 draft budget with three representatives making presentations at the State's town-hall meeting, with the Governor in attendance; and subsequently, at the appropriation public hearing at the State Legislature. As a result, a recommendation presented reflected in the final approved budget. Furthermore, the Hub in collaboration with other platforms are advocating for the establishment of a Ministry for Youth Empowerment & Development. As well as demanding for increased participation in policy formulation, implementation and evaluation.

Also, the Hub has organized a strategy session with over a 100 youths in attendance on the global OGP Strategy 2023-2028. Followed by the OGP Youth Scale-Up Campus Ignite held at the Kaduna State University (KADU), with close to 500 students in attendance. Currently, it is on learning visits to key government institutions to further understand the governance system. Importantly, the Hub is positioned to track the implementation of the 8 youth-specific 2024 budget line items - in line with the 4 identified youth-related action points in the SUSTAIN manifesto of Governor Uba Sani.

These progress markers can be attributed to the enabling environment provided by OGP

reforms in the State. As well as increased recognition of the need to mentor, empower and support the youths to effectively participate in governance. The Hub has gotten the buy-in and support of partners such as the Planning and Budget Commission, Partnership to Engage, Reform and Learn (PERL), Ihifix Innovation Foundation, Coalition of Associations for Leadership, Peace, Empowerment and Development (CALPED), Reset Nigeria, BIG Initiative, Save The Children International as well as Accountability Mechanisms and media in the State.

Indeed, Kaduna State has set the example for other sub-nationals to follow by changing the narrative through the OGP; and is gradually pulling down the barriers hindering effective youth participation in governance. With this new trajectory provided by the OGP community in the State, more youths are having interest, better understanding and actively participating in governance, thereby equipping them for future leadership positions.

Finally, with OGP Kaduna now providing the official entry point for more effective youth participation in governance, the State is better positioned to contribute to delivering the five strategic goals in the global OGP Strategy (2023-2028). This will ensure transparency, accountability, participation, and inclusion are embedded in the culture and practice of governments at all levels. Thereby ensuring the youths have an equal opportunity to participate freely in shaping public policies and decisions that impact their lives.

KDSG: Up in arms against Malaria

In commemoration of the 2024 world Malaria Day, Kaduna state deployed its personnel and materials to ensure that people in the state are availed of the dangers of the scourge and how to contain it. **Affiong Edim** reports on the effort to keep malaria at bay:

alaria is an infection by a microscopic parasite called plasmodium and spread by mosquitoes. Malaria is a preventable disease yet millions of people around the World get infected every year. The parasite is spread to human through the bites of infected mosquitoes.

While the disease is very common in tropical and subtropical climate it is uncommon in temperate climates. According to the World Malaria Report 2021, every year, about 290 million people are infected with malaria and more than 4000,000 people die of the disease. It is the third killer disease of children between 0-5 years following pneumonia and diarrhea.

The World Health Organization estimates that African Region carries a disproportionately high share of the global Malaria burden and accounts for about 94% of all malaria deaths. According to the National Malaria Indicator Survey (MIS 202) the prevalence of malaria among children under 5 years in Kaduna is 16%

As a disease of public Health concerns, Kaduna State Ministry of Health is continually intensifying effort to ensure the elimination of the disease. Commemorating the 2024 World Malaria Day is one of the avenues to publicly and collectively raise awareness for the elimination of the disease.

Speaking to pressmen during the commemoration of the 2024 World Malaria Day in Kaduna Dr. Aisha Abubakar Sadiq the Permanent Secretary, Kaduna State Ministry of Health noted that Kaduna State

Government has c o m m i t t e d e n o r m o u s resources to the Health Sector.

Prioritizing the Health sector by the Governor of Kaduna State, Senator Uba Sani is in keeping to his promise of the Sustain Agenda. The 764 public Health facilities are being supported to provide Malaria Services to the residents of Kaduna State aside the distribution of ACTs. RDTs to secondary and tertiary Health Facilities.

This commitment by the administration of His Excellency, is also very visibly in the second phase of the construction of one Primary Health Care Centre per ward across the 23 Local Government Areas in the State in line with the Universal Ward Health System which has reached advanced stage.

The Permanent Secretary further enumerated that the Ministry has achieved 68% refill rate order for all antimalarial commodities (DHIS) with a reduction of malaria test positivity rate from 33% (NDHS 2018) to 16% in 2021 (MIS 2021) thereby placing the state as the lowest prevalence in the North West Zone of the Country

Dr Aisha also noted that the Ministry has a robust partnership with international and national donor organizations adding that it is one of the thirteen Global Fund (GF) supported States in Nigeria for the Elimination of malaria and will be a beneficiary in Global Grant Cycle 7 (GCT Grant 2024).

While calling on all residents in the State to access and utilize the robust and free malaria services at any nearby Primary Health Care Centre she urged all residents to take responsibility to maintain environmental hygiene as a primary measure to prevent the Malaria scourge

In line with the 2024 World Malaria Day theme, "Accelerating Fight Against Malaria for A More Equitable World" the Ministry deployed the Mobile Diagnostics Trucks to Medical Outreach in some designated points across the Metropolis where free testing and treatment for malaria were provided to residents. During the Outreaches about 142 persons were screened for Malaria and 12 persons returned positive while many were also screened for Hepatitis and Tuberculosis.

sustainability of WASH facilities provided by the Government, its development partners and to encourage its ownership by the Communities, RUWASSA in partnership with UNICEF Nigeria, Kaduna Field Office has empowered ninety eight (98) State, Local Government officials and Local Area Mechanics on Operation and Maintenance of Facility Management Models and Data Management for Small Towns and Rural Water Facilities.

Participants at the empowerment workshop were drawn from the State, the Local Government Areas of the State excluding Kaduna North which is purely urban.

Some of the objectives of the training include:

1. To strengthen, leverage on Local

Government Authorities resources to utilise LAMs to provide/ restore access to safe water in the communities, institutions and public places.

- 2. To strengthen the capacity of the LGA officials and LAM's on repairs, operations and maintenance of boreholes.
- 3. To build capacity of LGA officials on Facility Management Models and agreed on alternative tariff system to improve functionality and sustainability of water facilities.
- 4. To review/finalise on reporting templates.
- 5. To develop action plans to achieve 2024 water supply related targets including step down training at the LGA level

Introducing Facility Management Models and tariff system has become necessary as it will help in maintaining water quality, repairs of brokendown facility, modernise the facility, serve as preventive

maintenance services, helps in facility expansion, and help in sustainability of the facility as well as encourage community ownership of the facility.

During the training, participants were trained on the roles and responsibilities of officers on Facility Management Models, deciding Facility Management Models, tariff system- pay and alternatives to tariffs, Financial Accountability, to mention a few.

At the end of the training participants expressed their gratitude to the organisers of the programme, the resource persons and made a commitment to step down the training in their various LGA in line with the Sustain Agenda of Governor Uba Sani.

Gov Uba Sani launches N500m revolving loan scheme for Kaduna workers

This is witnessed by the expanded footprint of Operation Whirl Punch across the State which has further brought succour to residents. We remain immensely grateful to the Nigerian Army hierarchy for this unwavering commitment to ensuring peace and stability in Kaduna State.

Permit me to re-emphasize the safe return of 137 students of Kuriga Community schools from their abductors, as a testament to the collaboration between the Kaduna State Government and the leadership of the Nigerian Army.

Accordingly, I am optimistic that a gathering of this nature with the participation of various stakeholders within the national security architecture, and accomplished retired generals, will provide viable solutions to the challenges confronting our country. Security Forces must integrate Local Communities into their security plans

Remarks by the Governor of Kaduna State, his Senator Uba Sani at the capacity building programme organised by the Nigeria Police Force school's protection squad on 8th may 2024 at Yar'adua Hall, Murtala Square, Kaduna

he theme of this Capacity Building programme "Strengthening Security Resilience and Integration of Host Communities in the Protection of Education" is apt. No nation can achieve its human capital development goals, and infact make giant developmental strides if it fails to guarantee the safety and security of schools. And for you to effectively guarantee the safety and security of schools, you must build the capacity of security forces and communities to anticipate, prepare for, reduce the impact of, cope with, and recover from the effects of shocks and stresses. It follows therefore that security forces must integrate host communities in their security plans and execute effective Psychological Operations to win the hearts and minds of the people.

I commend the Federal Government for launching the N144.8 Billion Safe Schools Financing Plan in 2022. The plan was developed through rigorous consultative strategic engagements with all relevant stakeholders in the education and security sectors, at national and sub-national levels. It is gratifying to note that in furtherance of this plan, the Inspector General of Police, IGP Olukayode Egbetokun has established the Schools Protection Squad (SPS), a proactive initiative aimed at enhancing security and safety in educational institutions across Nigeria.

Kaduna State is one of the states that has been waging a sustained battle against banditry, terrorism, kidnapping and other forms of criminality. These non - state actors have disrupted socio - economic activities in the affected communities and are threatening our educational revitalization programme. Kaduna State's educational system is facing a crisis of declining enrolment, with over 200,000 fewer primary school pupils recorded in the 2022/2023 academic session compared to the previous year. This dramatic drop (from 2,111,969 in 2021/2022 to 1,734,704 in 2022/2023) is largely attributed to insecurity.

In several Local Government Areas (LGAs) particularly Chikun, Birnin Gwari, Kajuru, Giwa, and Igabi insecurity has forced school consolidation, further pushing up the number of out-of-school children. Incidents like the kidnapping of 135 students from the LEA Primary and Junior Secondary School, Kuriga, Chikun Local Government tragically illustrates the devastating impact of insecurity on education access and safety.

To ensure that the education of our children in conflicts prone and terrorists infested areas is not interrupted, we have commenced the merging of 359 schools with those in safe locations. We are also implementing our SAFE SCHOOL PROGRAM to strengthen the security in our primary and secondary schools. We are collaborating with the Nigeria Police Force which is currently training a Schools Protection

Squad (SPS). We have made adequate budgetary provision for effective implementation of our Safe School Program.

The following measures are being implemented:

- Fencing of schools
- Establishment of Security and Safety Response Committees with membership drawn from schools and communities.
- Deployment of Kaduna Vigilance Service (KADVS) to schools.
- Provision of emergency line to schools
- Security Awareness Training for School Managers, teaching and non-teaching staff and School Based Management Committee members.
- Construction of Muster Points in schools.
- Training on identification of Early Warning Signs.
- Construction of Watch Tower in schools.

Civic vigilance is essentially about the will of the people and how they express such will in securing their environment and their future. In recognition of the fact that our main weapon against terrorists, bandits and insurgents are the people because these criminal elements live among them, the Kaduna State Government has developed a Framework for Psychological Operations, aimed at winning the hearts and minds of the people. We have been holding regular meetings with Elders, Religious Leaders, Youth, Women and Development Associations.

We are a resilient people. What our people have gone through and still going through are enough to break the spirits of people in other climes. To renew the confidence of our people and restart the process of rebuilding local economies, we must assist security forces and our people to acquire new skill sets. Managing risks, investing in resilience, and responding to shocks when they occur is a shared responsibility of governments, communities and the private sector.

It is my hope that this Capacity Building Programme will not only equip the participants with the skills and techniques of coping in challenging security situations, but will develop a Framework for Psychological Operations and Strategic Communication to Win the Hearts and Minds of Citizens in Conflicts Challenged Communities. Security forces must hold regular meetings with elders, religious leaders, representatives of youth and women groups. Consultative Committees on Security should be formed in communities, with membership drawn from security forces and key stakeholders. They can play a key role in gathering intelligence, mobilizing the citizens on security and development issues, as well as nipping potential crisis in the bud.

Gov Sani Boosts Security with Vehicles and Motorcycles


